

UNCathlon Scoring

At UNCathlon, we 'Unify' our athletes with corporate partners, law enforcement, student teams and volunteers to help raise funds to fuel our mission. Teams participate in various competitive sporting events and skills challenges. You might be asking, 'How does my team win?' You win by collecting the most points throughout the event; ranking higher through faster times, longer distances, and higher scores based on the challenge.

The competition consists of eight (8) sporting events, *including a bocce roll, football toss, a 40-yard dash, field goal kicks, and other skills-based competitions.*

Fundraising is the FINAL EVENT. And "double points" scoring for that is based on how much money your team!

How scoring works: Based on a 25-team system

- The type of sport/activity will determine how the team is placed in 1st, 2nd, 3rd...
- For each of the eight rounds, the 1st place team will get 25 points, 2nd place will get 24 points, 3rd place 23 points and so on
- The fundraising "event" yields DOUBLE POINTS (i.e., 1st place fundraising team in a field of 25 gets 50 points, 2nd place gets 48 points, 3rd place gets 46 points, etc.)
- Your total points earned from all eight events, combined with your fundraising double points, will be tallied together to get your final score

Each team member and athlete is encouraged to participate in fundraising for this event to earn the points associated with the "double points" FUNdraising challenge.

As a sponsor, your team/teams will have a head start in fundraising.

- Any sponsor \$2,500 or higher starts with \$2,500 for the team. Additional fundraising done by the team members will be added to your overall team total
- Sponsorships \$2,500 or lower will be included in the team contribution to the event
- All Peer-to-Peer fundraising by individual team members count toward the team total

The team that raises the highest amount wins the fundraising event. Each additional team receives points as outlined in the scoring section above.

***Sponsorship credit toward the fundraising event is capped at \$2,500 per team**
